

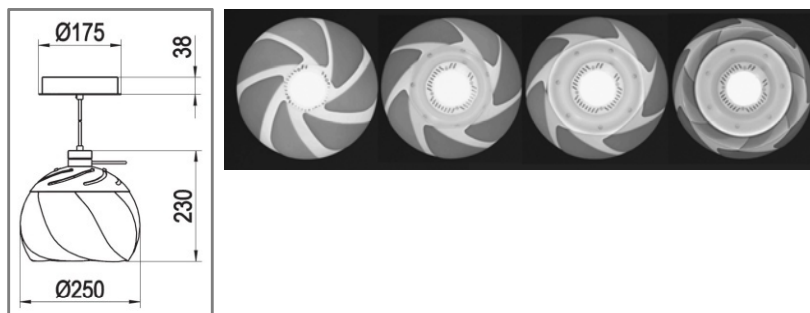
In 2015, for its "highly successful design and well thought out detail solutions" the Pirouet fantasy lamp received a „honourable mention” award from the jury of Red Dot, one of the world’s most prestigious design competitions. The plans were made by Malte Koslowski and Georg Dwalischwil, who graduated from the Process and Product Design Institute of Berlin Art University. In addition the design, also the prototypes were made in their own design studio in Berlin, which was founded in 2013.

Inspired by a petals of flower, the leaf-shaped diffusers of this unusual lamp can change their appearance and lighting effect by opening and closing. Its mechanical adjustment facility allows the lamp to adapt in line with individual needs, creating precisely the right lighting mood. The Pirouet is available in light colour 3000K or 4000K and is fitted with 8W LEDs, which provide a luminous flux of 972 lumen, so it also meets not only aesthetics, but energy efficiency and environmental aspects, as well.
